## Extension Activities

1. Play "Categories" with types of vegetables. In a circle, each student takes a turn naming different vegetables. The teacher records the responses on the board. If a student cannot come up with a new one, they can pass. Farmer Ashley grows 75 types of vegetables. How many vegetables can your class name?
2. Do a comparative taste test of a fruit or vegetable that has varieties of many colors - like the red and purple radishes that Farmer Ashley grows. How is the look, smell, taste, and texture similar and different from one another?
3. Draw the unique leaf of radicchio with red, purple, and green. See if you can match colors and patterns you see on the leaf in the video. Remember the ABCD's of scientific drawings: accurate, big, COLORFUL, detailed.
4. Look at your school cafeteria menu. Circle each fruit or vegetable with the color of that fruit or vegetable. How many colors will you eat in your school cafeteria this week?
